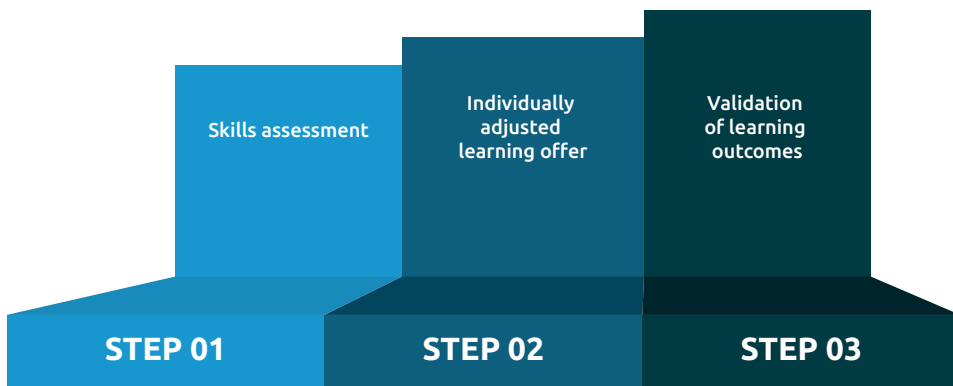

The project responds to *the Recommendation on Upskilling Pathways: New Opportunities for Adults* adopted by the Council of the European Union on 19 December 2016. Its aim is **to provide educational support for adults with low basic skills** in literacy, numeracy and digital skills as well as social competences. It is implemented in a 3-stage process:



What is the main aim of the project?

The project's aim is to develop and test **innovative models** of providing educational support **to adults with low basic skills**.

Who gets a chance? The project's target groups

Adults with low basic skills, who are:

- 1) **employees** (especially of SMEs),
- 2) **jobless** (inactive in the labour market and/or unemployed), e.g. people who want to enter or return to the labour market after a long absence, women after a long period of raising children, persons caring for dependents,
- 3) **from disadvantaged areas** (rural and/or small towns and/or urban post-industrial areas, those with difficult access to education), including areas cited in the Act of 9 October 2015 on revitalization as well as government regional programmes (Programme for Silesia, Programme for the Bieszczady Mountains),
- 4) **aged 50+**,
- 5) **cognitively disabled**,
- 6) **affected by sensory and/or physical disabilities**,
- 7) **affected by abuse** (e.g. physical, mental, economic),
- 8) **immigrants**.

Who can be a grant recipient?

Grant recipients can be, among others:

- continuing education centres
- education institutions for adults
- libraries and other cultural institutions
- education and vocational counselling centres
- local government units
- people's universities
- open universities
- universities of the third age
- social welfare centres
- social cooperatives
- associations and foundations working with people lacking basic skills
- businesses promoting learning at work
- craft chambers
- labour market institutions
- employers' organisations
- trade unions
- awarding bodies operating in the Integrated Qualifications System
- other entities involved in supporting adults with low basic skills.

An applicant may apply for a grant individually or in partnership with other entities.
